**Got Seaweed?:** Touch and explore seaweed & its importance in the ocean and in your home.

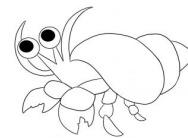
**Marine Skulls:** Explore and compare real skulls and bones of marine animals!
