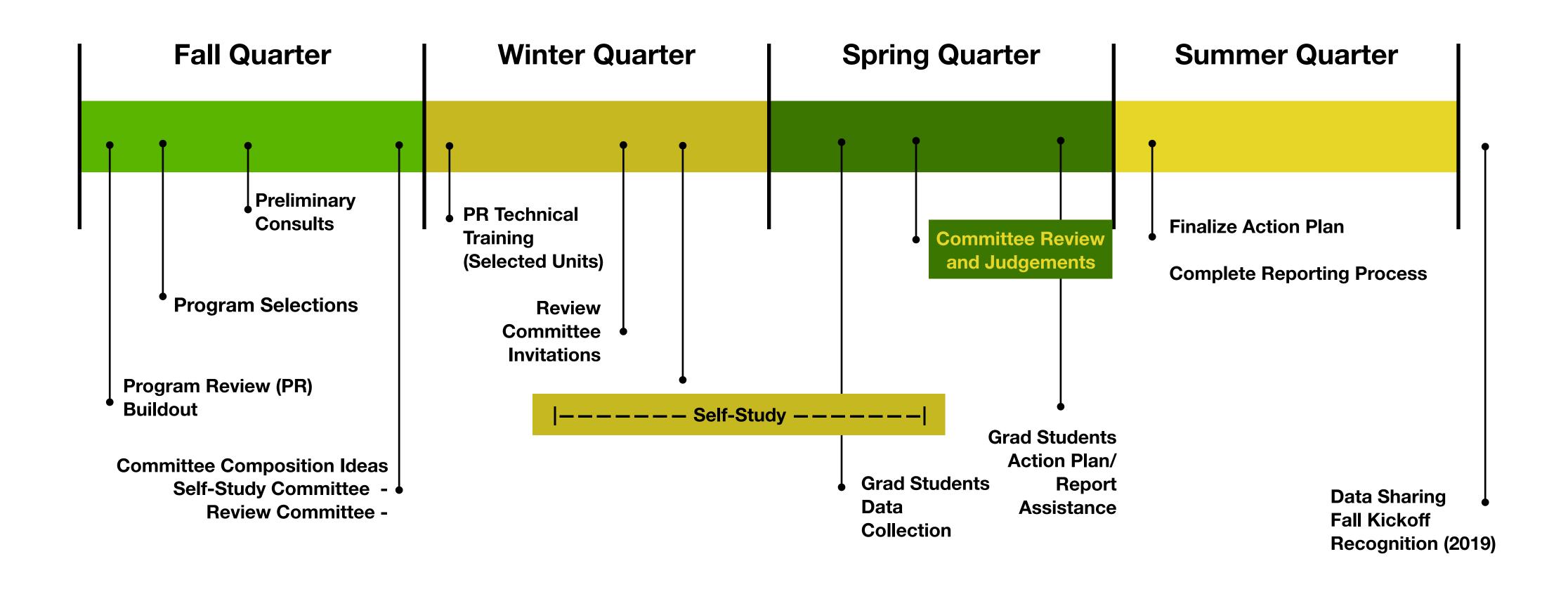

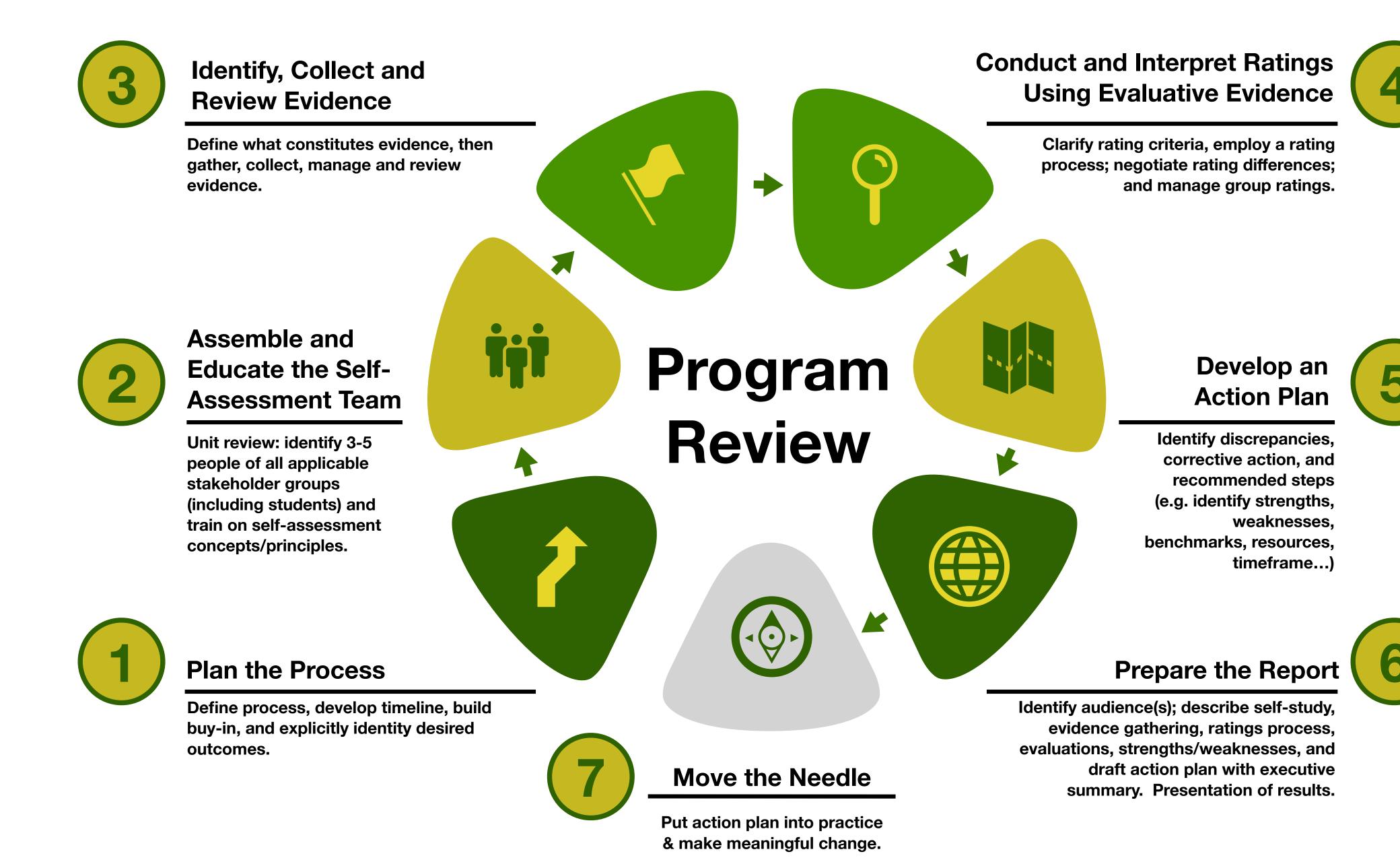

Student Affairs Program Review 2018-2019 Roadmap





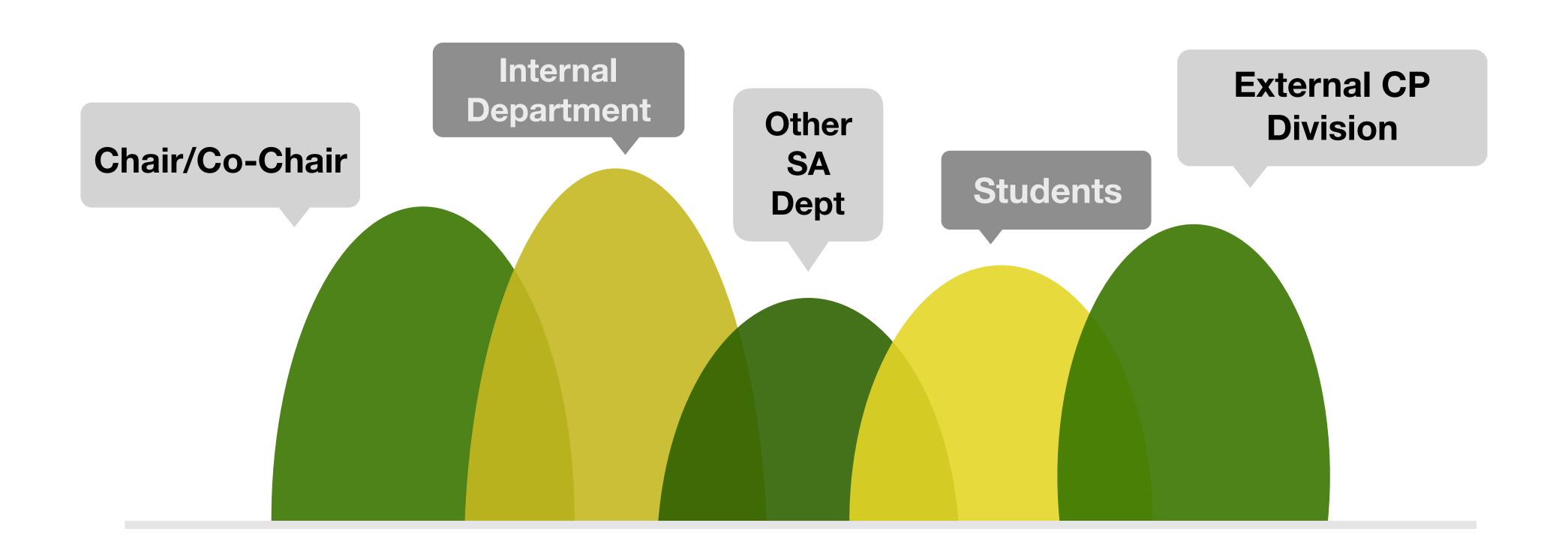
DEFINITIONS:

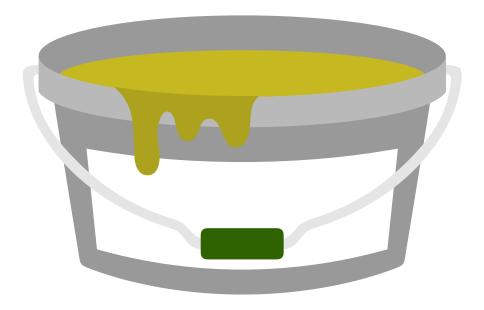


Event Totals Attendance by Constituency Co-/Curricular Programs

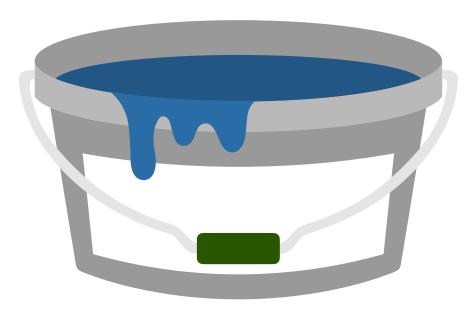

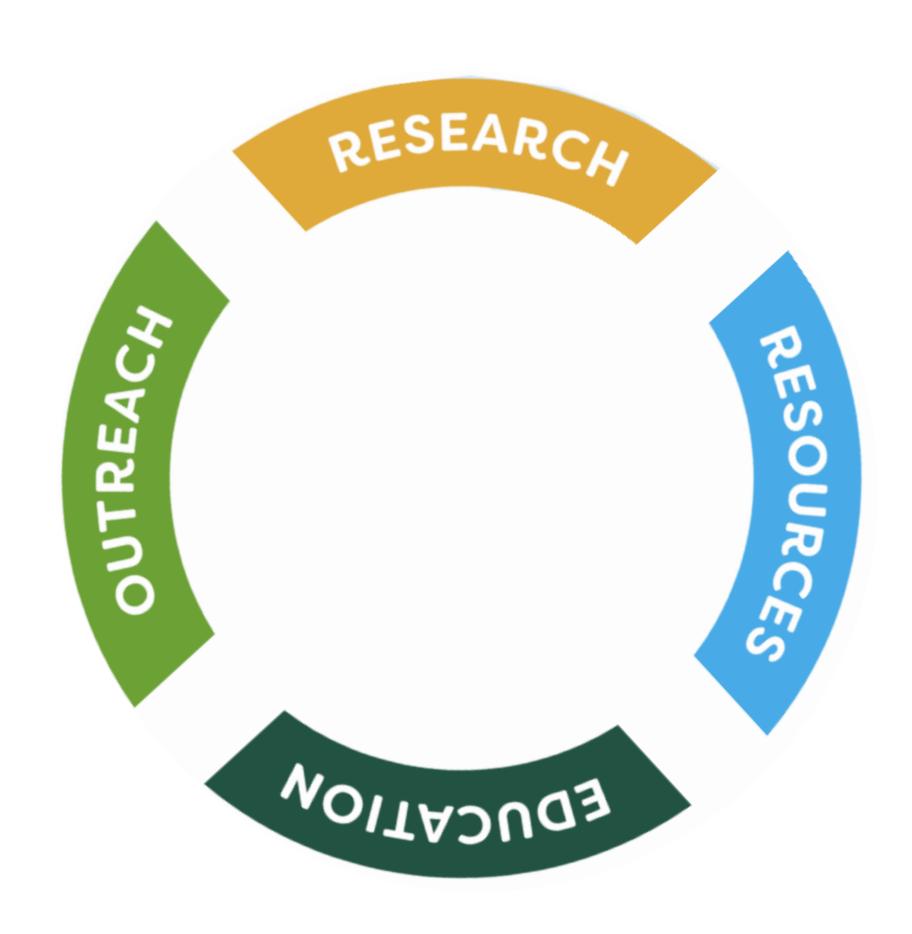

The Bystander Benchmark Study

- California Public Pilot (Spring '19)
 - 10 Campuses between the CSU and UC systems.
- Currently live
- 5,000 students invited per campus
 - Random stratified sample

- Field testing
 - Fall 2018 Statistics partnership
 - Timing, language, sequence
 - Interviews with feedback
- "Learn by Doing"
- Sexual violence opt out

The Bystander Benchmark Study

- Exposure, Prevalence and Bystander Response
 - Sexual Harassment/Assault/Violence
 - Alcohol & Other Drugs (including prescription)
 - Hate & Discriminatory Bias Speech/Actions
 - Hazing

- Is ___ an issue?
- Can ____ be positively changed?
- Would you intervene?
- How frequently did you witness ____?
- Did you step-in and do something?
- What prohibited you from doing something (factors listed)?



Non-Intervention: Unhealthy Alcohol Use

It wasn't any of my business (48%)

The situation made me feel unsafe (36%)

My relationship with them made it complicated (36%)

I didn't think it was an issue/big deal (35%)

I was distracted at the time (34%)

I didn't know what to do (31%)

I assumed somebody else would do something (28%)

The person deserved/chose what was happening (19%)

I thought I could get in trouble (11%)

Concerned about what my friends would think (10%)

I was paralyzed and couldn't act (8%)

Establishing Baseline Numbers

How often did you witness "hard" or "illicit" drug usage over the 2018 Fall academic term?

i.e. Heroin, Cocaine, Meth or Hallucinogens (LSD/Mushrooms)

Never - 64.70%

Once - 16.13%

Monthly - 14.34%

Weekly - 4.48%

Daily - .36%

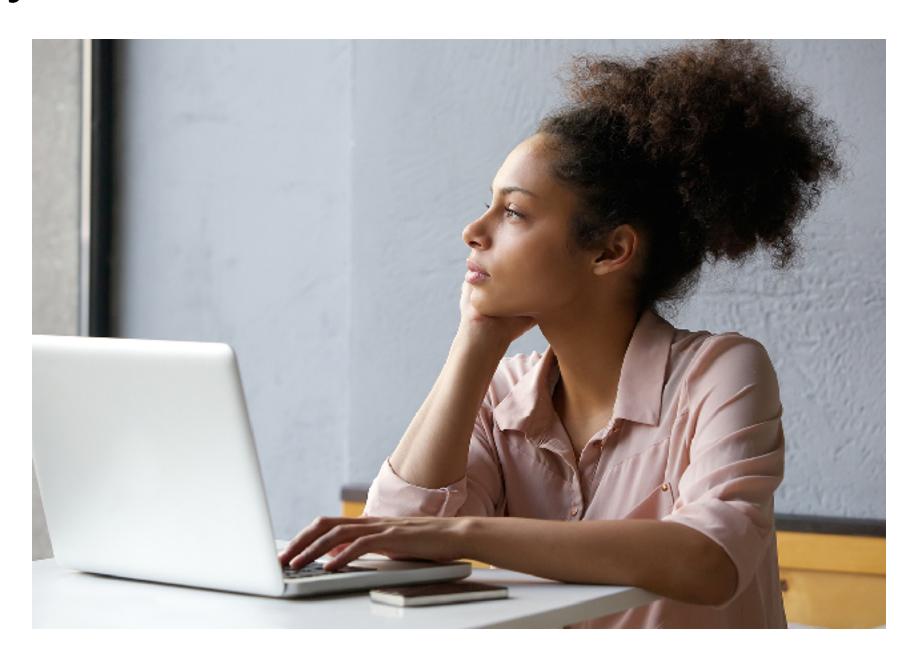
During Fall 2018, I witnessed another student (or personally) drive "under the influence" of drugs or alcohol.

| <u>Drugs</u> | <u>Alcohol</u> |
|------------------|-----------------|
| Never - 74.12% | Never - 76.24% |
| Once - 10.55% | Once - 16.67% |
| Monthly - 10.30% | Monthly - 6.38% |
| Weekly - 4.77% | Weekly - 0.71% |
| Daily - 0.25% | Daily - 0.00% |

 - Sexual Assault (2.17)

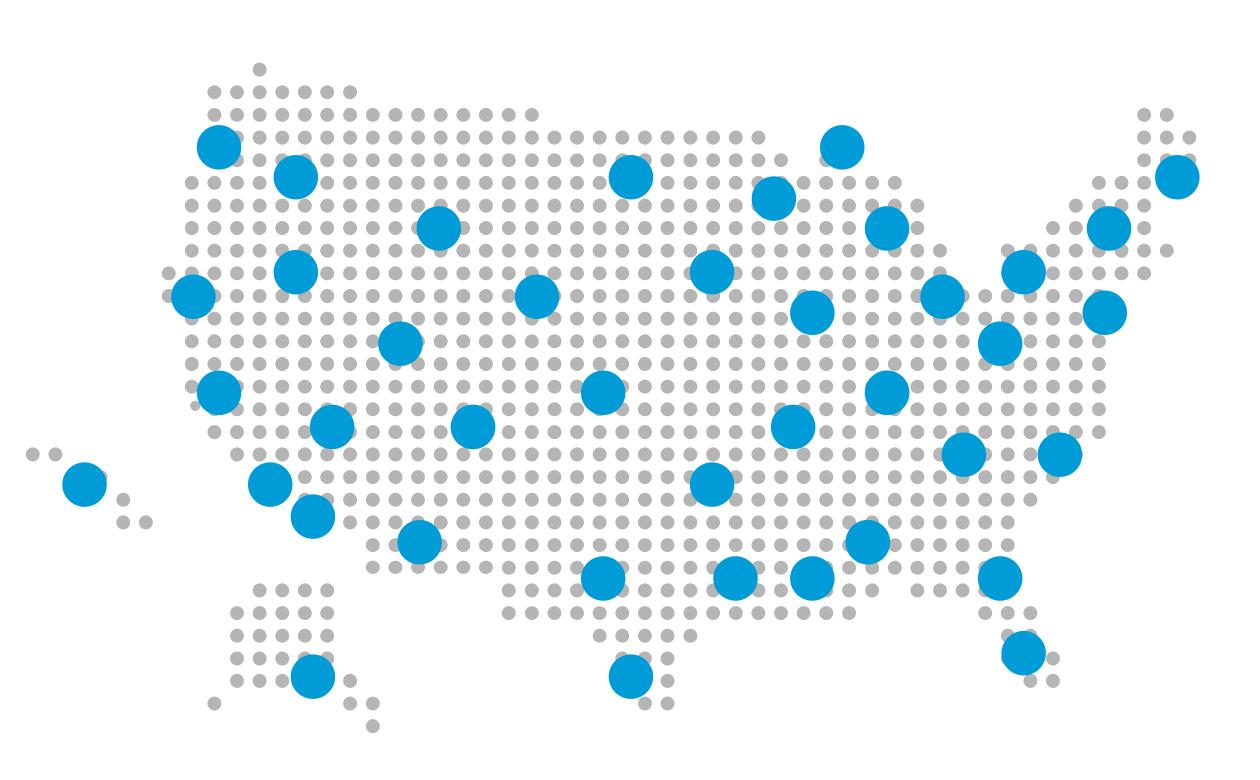

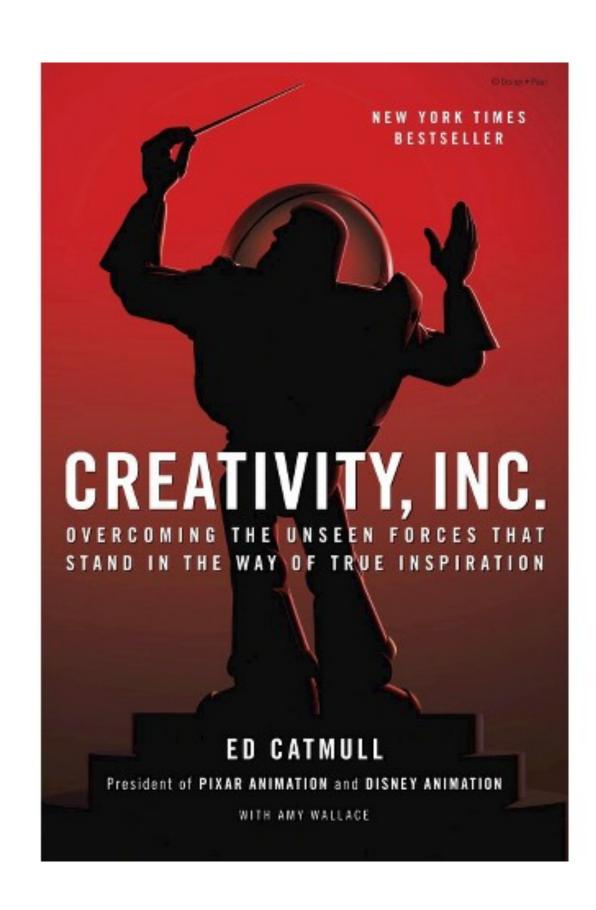
