WHEREAS,	faculty, students, and staff overwhelmingly support the retention of University Hour in its present form, and
WHEREAS,	a survey of faculty and students indicates an extensive utilization of the University Hour for meetings, colloquia, etc., and
WHEREAS,	Cal Poly is already operating at 21% over the rated facilities capacity, therefore be it
RESOLVED,	that University Hour (Thursday, 11 AM) be retained in its present form, and be it further
RESOLVED,	that scheduling of classes during University Hour as permitted under Section 235.2B of CAM be kept to a minimum, and be it further
RESOLVED,	that scheduling of classes on Tuesday at 11 AM be kept to a minimum.
