RESOLUTION REGARDING CREDIT/NO CREDIT GRADING IN P.E. LEVEL 100 COURSES

WHEREAS,	many Physical Education Level 100 activity courses do not lend themselves readily to grade discrimination, and
WHEREAS,	the recreational objectives of these courses are thought to be better accomplished if the pressure of "making a high letter grade" is removed, and
WHEREAS,	Physical Education Instructors report that the Credit/No Credit grading system seems to provide a more conducive climate for conducting an activity class, therefore be it
RESOLVED,	that the Academic Senate support and endorse the current policy of the Physical Education Department to use Credit/No Credit

grading in P.E. Level 100 activity courses (PE 100-199).
