**NOTES:**

During the winter quarter we have continued campuswide communication efforts regarding the timeline for implementation of new Area A and B guidelines. These have included ongoing improvements to the GE website and presentations to various campus constituencies.

We achieved a major goal in establishing the new GE blueprint on campus with Senate approval of the resolution containing new guidelines for Areas C, D, and E.
