This discussion will continue next quarter, with a goal of crafting a resolution for the consideration of the Senate.

The ASCC met via Zoom in most weeks of the quarter, at our regular meeting time of R 3-5. In addition to the above, we spent time discussing the mapping of currently approved online courses (those that went through under the old e-Addendum) to the new modalities. In the context of OLT&L review, we discussed the difficulty of evaluating lab and activity modes in online modalities (it's not always clear what that means).
