STAY CALM AND FOLLOW PROTOCOL



- Do not physically intervene.
- Contact the Cal Poly Police Department (CPPD) immediately: 805-756-2281 or dial 911 in an emergency.
- Notify George Hughes, Associate Vice President of Public Safety (Cal Poly's designated university official).

UNDERSTAND ICE AUTHORITY



- Public Areas: ICE may be present in open areas such as sidewalks and quads.
- Non-Public Areas: classrooms, offices and residence halls require a judicial warrant signed by a judge.
- Contact George Hughes by contacting CPPD at 805-756-2281 or dial 911 in an emergency.

- Student and employee information is protected under FERPA and other privacy laws.
- Do not release personal information or records unless required by a valid court order.
