**RESOLUTION ON SWITCHING TO A ONE-YEAR CYCLE
OF CATALOG REVIEW**

Impact on Existing Policy: none

- 1 WHEREAS, Beginning with the 2019-20 Catalog, Cal Poly switched from a two-
2 year cycle of catalog review to a one-year cycle; and

4 WHEREAS, this switch was initially temporary, necessary to facilitate the
5 implementation of the new General Education template mandated by
6 EO 1100; and

8 WHEREAS, the one-year cycle of catalog review allows departments and
9 programs to more rapidly propose and implement desired changes,
10 allowing a more fluid and responsive curriculum; and

12 WHEREAS, programs and departments are not required to edit program
13 curriculum annually except as desired; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED: that Cal Poly switch to a one-year cycle of catalog review.
