#### Other Discussion Topics:

Double counting courses between majors and minors was continued to be discussed, and individual meetings were held with faculty in Wine and Viticulture. We will continue to investigate this issue and plan to propose a resolution at the beginning of Winter 2017 quarter.

We also have continued our discussion of the Blended Program and met with representatives from the Computer Science department. A policy needs to be created for these programs, and the committee reviewed a draft proposal on this. Discussions will be continued with individual departments in the fall, and we plan to propose a resolution in the middle of Winter 2017.

On May 12, the ASCC and representatives from the GEGB met with Brian Tietje to discuss the Quarter Plus Program. There is some concern that the number of hours needed for in and out of class activities (approximately 30 per unit) cannot be achieved in three weeks (9 credits are taken by the students). Currently there is no approval process for offering courses in a compressed timeframe after a course has already been approved. It was suggested that a study on student learning outcomes be conducted to fully assess the Quarter Plus Program.
