Ongoing	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Ongoing.</p> <p>ATESS policies are complete.</p> <p>Policies on evaluation of instruction and professional services, professional development, and service were lower priority than other UFPP related projects and have been pushed to next AY.</p> <p>In Spring 2023 we took on the project of streamlining faculty evaluation processes through revisions to UFPP. Two drafts of revised policy for UFPP 6.2 and 6.3 are now out for consultation into Fall 2023. We aim to move these to the Senate in Fall 2023. More revisions to UFPP under this theme are coming in AY 2023-24.</p>
