| Work with Sustainability Committee to develop sustainable pathways in General Education.                                  | In all honesty, I was not aware of this “charge.” I do not know who sits on the sustainability committee, I have never been contacted by the committee, and I am not sure what role the GEGB should have in creating “pathways.”   |
| Ongoing review of curriculum proposals: catalog cycle proposals and continuous course review proposal.                    | There were only a handful of minor course modifications submitted; they were approved. As chair, I have also been consulting faculty members/departments who intend to propose GE courses. I sent a memo to the campus community in November offering guidance for faculty proposing GE courses. |
| Explore “course renewal” cycle (in tandem with ASCC). <b>Ongoing.</b>   | This work has been moved to winter and spring while the GEGB works on the new EOs (see below).   |
| Work with appropriate groups to develop criteria for GWR expansion and submit a resolution for approval. <b>Fall 2017</b> | I have been working with the GWR committee to draft a proposal for GWR expansion. This work will stretch into winter quarter.  |

### **NOTES:**

It seems like a key charge for the GEGB this year is not addressed above. Much of the work this quarter has been devoted to understanding the newly revised EO 1100, the CSU’s governing document for GE, as well as EO 1110, which addresses developmental classes. The new EO 1100 requires some significant changes to our GE program: moving Area F classes,

realigning our GE program with the CSU GE pattern, double counting upper-division GE classes, etc. As part of this effort, I have met regularly with Bruno Giberti and Mary Pedersen in Academic Programs. With Bruno, I presented on EO 1100 and 1110 to the Academic Senate and to the CLA chairs council. We also sent a memo to the campus community addressing the EOs. I intend to continue this kind of outreach in Winter and Spring. We will also be focusing on bringing our Area F courses into compliance with EO 1100.

As GEGB chair, I also sit on the International Programs committee as well as the new USCP committee.
