Brand Governance Committee

Functions

The Brand Governance Committee develops standards and recommends policy for campus marketing and communication tools including, but not limited to, websites, mobile applications, social media, publications, merchandise, and campus signage. The committee is responsible for developing and submitting for approval to the President, or designee, the following:

- a. Visual Design Standards for the Cal Poly brand;
- b. Communications Standards for Cal Poly programs (e.g., Student Orientation, Advising and Registration, aka SOAR);
- c. Content Standards, as applicable;
- d. Compliance/Enforcement Policies, particularly for trademark licensing; and
- e. Other, as deemed necessary.

The Brand Governance Committee will delegate to appropriate subcommittees the task of developing; presenting to the President, or designee, for approval; disseminating; and enforcing the above-described standards. The committee would adjudicate requests for exceptions to the policies in consultation with the appropriate division vice president. Decisions by the committee could be appealed to the appropriate vice president for the division that is affected, who would consult with the President, or designee. The decision of the President, or designee, would be final.
