Internship Objective:

Internship Outline:

Students selected to be interns will work in various departments working with product-quality, profitability-enhancement and customer service or mechanization. Each intern will interface with various departments of the company, such as Sales & Marketing, Farming, Harvesting, Post-Harvest operations, IT and Finance, and may spend part of his or her time in the field. Each intern will have the opportunity to participate in a 2-day immersive orientation to network with other interns and learn about all areas of the company at the start of their internship. A mid-internship evaluation will take place with each intern's manager and the CEO & President of the company and an exit interview with the CEO & President of the company will take place at the conclusion of the internship.

During the internship program, interns will work with experienced managers in the industry and will learn about issues affecting agriculture, produce in particular, and the continued development of America's food supply. If assigned a project under the guidance of Tanimura & Antle's management team, he or she may or may not make a presentation to senior management of the company at the conclusion of their internship.
