We are looking for a longterm freelance writer based in the Central Coast that knows Ag well, can write well, and take quality photos with a real camera (not a phone camera) to be paid (\$150-\$250) on a per story basis. We are looking for one to two 800-1,500 word stories per month. These stories will come from covering agricultural industry meetings/seminars related to soil/irrigation/pest/disease management, farmer profile stories, and current Ag issues relevant to commodity-specific industries.

Requirements:

- a reliable vehicle for traveling to farms and industry meetings/seminars
- a quality camera
- general understanding of the vegetable, tree fruit, vineyard, tree nut, and dairy industries (may be assigned to write for any of our five farming publications below)
- discipline to complete stories in a timely manner to meet the demands of our monthly publication deadlines
- dress and groom professionally whenever covering writing assignments in meeting with farmers & industry representatives.

*Note that this is not a full-time job, the freelance writer would be treated as an independent contractor
