Job Description: Tour guides/interns will go through training to become a Moo U tour guide. If out of state you will be sent a training manual and we can do over the phone training if needed. You are required to have some background in agriculture, be it grow up on a ranch or farm or have upper level education in an area of agriculture. You will be required to talk on a portable PA system while giving tours. Standing on your feet and walking is required. We are staged under a tent which is outside. You

will be walking through the livestock barns talking on a portable mic. Tours are non scripted and you will give a maximum of four tours a day lasting approx 40 minutes. The rest of the time you will be visiting with folks that come up and ask about the tours. Some days you will give less tours than other days since it just depends on how busy we are.

. You will need to sign release form for background check (which is a requirement of most fairs) and also a non-compete form for Moo U. Please note you will housed with other tour guides/ sharing a room. You will be working with and talking to folks from all over the U.S. etc. Taking this contract job you will take sole responsibility for your interaction in regards to Covid. Moo U will not be responsible for your exposer or the fair we are contract with.
Housing, travel (air fare) are covered and all transportation to and from the fair. In Kansas we have a Airbnb and in Dallas TX where the State Fair of Texas is held we have an apartment. You will need 2-3 Moo U shirts which run from \$20.00-25.00. Jeans, capri's and closed toed shoes are the attire. You will work an 8 hour day with starting time varying depending on the fair. Starting pay is \$115.00 to \$125.00 per day depending on your livestock experience. This is contract work with no with holdings taken out of your check. At completion of your contract you will receive a check for your wages and another for reimbursement of airfare. Please note Kansas State Fair requires you to come in the day before for set up and you can leave the evening of the completion of fair or the next day. To receive your airfare covered for Dallas you must work a minimum of 12 days. (First 12 days arriving on Sept 23 or last 12 days arriving on October 5.0)
