We are a modern operation utilizing some of the latest equipment and technology (genomics, animal monitors, IT infrastructure, field equipment) with an emphasis on practicality. Both the animal and agronomic sides of the operation are intensively managed to maximize profit through a relentless focus on efficiency, animal husbandry, environmental stewardship and people.

Expansions in raw milk processing and the availability of land and water provide a bright future for the growth of the dairy industry in Georgia. Internships can be tailored based on the interest/skill set of the individual but are dependent upon the day to day needs of the dairy. Possible internship areas include;

Herd management: Work with each of our herdcare teams to gain a practical understanding of the dairy. Areas include reproduction, maternity, herd health, replacements and parlor management. Gain experience; breeding, palpating, DairyComp305, transition cow management, heat abatement, partial budgets

Crops: Barrington consistently grows the highest yielding and best quality forages in the southeast. Gain a practical understanding of; Nutrient and water management (lagoons, flush system, drag hose etc), harvest, tillage, pivot irrigation. Operate equipment and assist with maintenance and repairs. Attention to detail and basic mechanical ability required.

Feed: Gain experience; feeding cows, operating FeedWatch and managing forages and commodities. Exposure to ration formulation, commodity purchasing, logistics and hedging.

Veterinary: Work on the herd health team lead by our staff veterinarian; transition cow management, treatment/vaccine protocols, surgery, milk culture lab, diagnostic testing

Human Resources: Develop onboarding and department specific training modules. Help us develop and refine employee management processes and policies.

Mechanical: Department run by a licensed master electrician and team members include an RSES commercial refrigeration technician. Gain experience with; electrical controls, refrigeration, parlor maintenance and repairs (120 rotary and 2 parallel parlors), NMC parlor testing, food grade welding, parts inventories, new facility construction projects
