Robert L. Pender (1924-2011)

Robert L. Pender is remembered for his tireless civil work and dedication to various local San Francisco and national politics. In addition to serving his country in the U.S. Army from December 1942 to December 1944, Robert was also an active member of Broadmoor Presbyterian Church for 44 years. A resident of Parkmerced, Robert was passionate about his community and was a founding member and President Emeritus of the Parkmerced Resident Organization (PRO).

The Scholarship

The Parkmerced Robert L. Pender Memorial Scholarship was established in 2015 by the owners, management, and friends of Parkmerced to encourage career paths in engineering, architecture, urban planning, construction, and related fields. The \$1000 scholarship is awarded twice a year to a full-time student pursuing a certificate, undergraduate, or graduate program in those respective fields. Award priority will be given to those enrolled, or who intend to enroll, at San Francisco State University or City College of San Francisco.

The minimum criteria for selection are:

- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher;
- Current full-time enrollment with good standing in a certificate, undergraduate, or graduate degree program in engineering, architecture, urban planning, construction, or related field (including, but not limited to civil engineering, structural engineering, architecture, interior design, urban planning, construction management, or environmental studies);
- Demonstrated interest in addressing engineering, architecture, or urban planning issue(s);
- One (1) Letter of Recommendation from a current or past professor;
- Submission of a personal statement of 1,000 words or less highlighting candidate's interest in their field, relevant experiences and interests, and how this award will contribute to the candidate's ability to make a meaningful contribution to the respective field.

Applications must be submitted to Parkmerced in typewritten format. Scholarships are anticipated to be competitive and based on the applicant's specific career goals, need, academic record, and internship/professional experience. The award will be presented in July.
