Administrative fee at DIA € 500	€ 0.00 (no fees are requested through the Exchange Program Agreement). However, students going through the Independent Study Abroad Program provided by IEP will not pay Cal Poly tuition, but pay the DIA € 500
Student Union Fee (required)	€ 50 (approximate)
Inscription Fee (required)	€ 50 (approximate)
Health Insurance (required)	€ 100 (per month) mandatory Government required
Dormitory	€ 100-200/month (DIA will guarantee a place in the dorm before arrival according to the wishes of the student (single or shared occupancy/different price))

C. Description **Others important items**

- The German Government expects from each student attending the DIA to have approx. € 700/month of stay at his/her disposal. This includes all costs and represents a minimum.
- As for Visa application, exchange students that hold a US Passport do not need one on arrival. However, depending on their length of stay here the DIA, the Administration or the BA Course administration will regulate this matter locally on arrival. Other students

not holding American citizenship will have to undergo visa application process at their local (or nearest) German Consulate/Embassy, which would be either in Los Angeles or San Francisco.
