



Suggested Courses for Architecture (ARCH)

Recommendation: Fall Semester 2026 (16 units)

Please review your Degree Progress Report (DPR) through your student center to determine transfer credit that has been awarded. Follow the semester flowchart for transfer students (coming soon!) and speak frequently with a CAED Academic Advisor.

Major Courses:

- ARCH 4401 Advanced Architectural Design (5 units)
- ARCH 3331 Building Information Modeling (2 units)
- ARCH 3341 Architectural Systems Integration I (4 units)
- ARCH 4425 Seminar in Architectural History, Theory and Criticism (3 units) in Fall or Spring
- GE UD (*optional if not taking ARCH 4425 or ARCE*)

Support Courses:

- ARCE 1121 Structures I (3 units)
- If you have credit for ARCE 1121 Structures, Take a General Education (GE) Courses

Additional Notes:

- The department will consider each transfer student's academic record and create a worksheet that specifies the classes the student needs to take during the first fall and spring term at Cal Poly. During the preceding summer, the student will receive this worksheet by email, along with detailed instructions for registration.
- The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) will be taken in the required major course ARCH 492 (5th year).
- United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement must be satisfied before graduation.
- Classes can be found in Schedule Builder that will allow you to satisfy both GE area and the USCP requirement.
