



Suggested Courses for City & Regional Planning (CRP)

Recommendation: Fall Semester 2026 (15-18 units)

Please review your Degree Progress Report (DPR) through your student center to determine transfer credit that has been awarded. Follow the semester flowchart for transfer students and speak frequently with a CAED Academic Advisor.

Major Courses:

- CRP 1211 (4 units)
- CRP 1212 (4 units)
- CRP 3202 (4 units)
- CRP 2216 (3 units) **
- UD-GE Course (3 units)

Additional Notes:

- You may take an upper-division GE course if you feel prepared for an 18-unit workload in your first semester. Alternatively, if your goal is to graduate in two years, you might consider taking an upper-division GE, next summer instead.
- These courses are listed on the flowchart for transfer students. It is imperative that you take these 4 courses to stay on track. Some are prerequisites to other required courses and only offered in the fall semester
- Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) can be taken in a course OR by enrolling in UNIV 401. For more Info on the GWR, Visit: <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>
- United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement must be satisfied before graduation. Classes can be found in Schedule Builder that will allow you to satisfy both GE area and the USCP requirement.
