



Suggested Courses for Landscape Architecture Major (LA)

Recommendation: Fall 2026 (15-16 units)

- LA 1104 History of Landscape Architecture (3 units)
- LA 2203 Landscape Ecology: Concepts, Issues, and Interrelationships (3 units)
- PLSC 2234 Intro to Plant Materials (3 units)

Support Courses:

- EDES 1123 (3 units – GE 4B)

Additional Notes:

- Admitted transfer students who have done coursework that is equivalent to any lower division courses (first two years) in the Landscape Architecture curriculum should reach out to the department to discuss the possibility of course substitutions, or for additional units if suggested courses are already articulated
- MATH 1007 Precalculus coursework or course credit is required. If admitted students do not have general education credits for areas 5B and 5C, they should enroll in either BOT 1121 (General Botany) or BIO 1114 (Plant Diversity and Ecology) as it fits with their schedule
