- I. Recommended number of units for **Fall 2021**: 12-16 units
- II. Major Courses:
  - AEPS 101 (1 unit) – Orientation to Horticulture & Crop Science (*required in Fall*)
  - AEPS 120 (4 units) – Principles of Horticulture & Crop Science (*required in Fall*)
- III. Support Courses (*if not already fulfilled with transfer credit*):
  - SS 120 (4 units) – Intro. Soil Science or SS 221 (4 units) - Soil Health & Plant Nutrition
  - BOT 121 (4 units) – General Botany
  - BRAE 340 (4 units) – Irrigation Water Management (*Upper-Division B*)
- IV. Concentration Courses
  - Fruit & Crop Science: AEPS 203, 205 or 333 Enterprise (2 units) or Approved Electives area
  - Environmental Horticulture Science: AEPS 234 (4 units) – Plant Materials II or Approved Electives area
  - Plant Protection Science: AEPS 203, 205, 212 or 333 Enterprise (2 units) or Approved Electives area
