- II. Major Courses:
 - NR 140 (1 unit) – Careers in Natural Resources Mmgmt & Environmental Sci. (*fall only*)
 - ERSC 144 (4 units) – Introduction to Earth Science (*fall only*)
 - NR 218 (3 units) – Applications in GIS
 - BOT 121 (4 units) – General Botany
 - SS 120 (4 units) – Intro. Soil Science OR SS 221 (4 units) - Soil Health & Plant Nutrition
- III. Concentration Courses OR Advisor Approved Electives (*select one*)
 - All students are automatically placed in the Approved Electives area (which includes 12 units of Free Electives). The Approved Electives area is often used to pursue a Minor.
