



FALL 2021 SUGGESTED COURSES FOR WINE AND VITICULTURE (WVIT) TRANSFER STUDENTS

12 to 16 units recommended for fall quarter 2021.

Major Courses: If not already fulfilled with transfer credit (please check pre-requisites)

- WVIT 102 (4) – Global Wine & Viticulture (*required in fall*)
- WVIT 202 (4) – Fundamentals of Wine & Viticulture (*required in fall*)
- WVIT 233 (4) – Basic Viticulture (if completed AEPS 120 or BOT 121, CHEM 127, SS 121)
- WVIT 331 (4) – Advance Viticulture (if completed AEPS/WVIT 231 or WVIT 232 or WVIT 233)

Support Courses: If not already fulfilled with transfer credit (please check pre-requisites)

- AGB 214 (4) – Financial Accounting
- BOT 121 (4) – General Botany
- BRAE 340 (4) – Irrigation Water Management (double counts as **UD-B**) ***
- CHEM 127 (4) – General Chemistry
- ECON 222 (4) – Macroeconomics
- MATH 141, 161, or 221 (4) Calculus
- STAT 218 (4) – Applied Statistics Life Science
- SS 120 (4) – Intro. to Soil Science

Concentration Courses:

- Enology –129, 312, MCRO 221, WVIT 404, Advisor Approved Electives
- Viticulture –AEPS 313, 321, 323, 312, SS 221, Advisor Approved Electives
- Wine Business – AGB 212, AGB 260, AGB 369 **or** BUS 384, RPTA 320, Advisor Approved Electives
- CHEM 128 (4) --General Chemistry II (**For Enology and Viticulture Concentrations, only**- Typically not offered Fall term at Cal Poly, but suggested to take at a Community college during fall term, to stay on track)

General Education (GE) Courses: If not already fulfilled with transfer credit

- GE Area- **Upper Division C** (can also include the GWR** or USCP*)
- GE Area- **Upper Division D** (try to include the USCP, if needed*)
- GE Area- **UD-B** –must take major requirement: **BRAE 340 (4)** ***

Additional Notes:

- * **United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP)** is a requirement before graduation. To find **USCP classes** in [Schedule Builder](#) or [Class Search](#), (found in your Student Center) Change “Course Attribute” to “US Cultural Pluralism”.
- ****The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR)** must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-approved, upper-division course (usually the Upper Div GE-C) OR by completing the [GWR portfolio](#) your final term at Cal Poly.
