#### **License Plate Recognition is Live, Repurpose Your Physical Permit and Win**

### Campus Can Now Use Grubhub, not Tapingo, for Campus Dining Venues

The campus community can now save time and receive special offers through the Grubhub app. Earlier this year Grubhub purchased Tapingo, the app used by Campus Dining for mobile ordering. Just last week Grubhub officially began integrating Tapingo into the Grubhub app. Users now must use the Grubhub app for all their mobile food ordering from Campus Dining venues. Since Tapingo is no longer active, users just need to download the Grubhub app and login. All Tapingo accounts have been migrated to Grubhub and users can simply sign in with their previous login information. If users didn't previously use the Tapingo app, they can open a Grubhub account, and in settings under My Grubhub confirm California Polytechnic as their campus. This change offers access to all Campus Dining venues except Yogurt Creations and Shake Smart.

### Staff Parking Available in K-2 Lot Behind North Mountain Residence Halls

Staff can take advantage of a designated parking lot near the east side of campus. The reconfigured R-1 parking lot consists of the southern two terraces of parking stalls located directly across Klamath Road from Trinity Hall, south of Mountain Lane. The area located north of Mountain Lane has been designated as the K-2 parking lot. The K-2 parking lot is designated as a staff lot Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The K-2 lot can be accessed via Village Drive and Mountain Lane from North Perimeter Road and is marked and available for staff parking.
