

Instructions

For this assignment you will submit your final Learning Unit Plan for one topic/module of your course, that will include the following: title and description of unit, three learning objectives, two content items, two activities, and



one formative assessment. All content, activities and assessments must align with the learning objectives, to help your students master course concepts. We have divided this assignment into three parts to guide you, and provide a sample below.

Please review this sample for guidance: <u>Sample Final Learning Unit Plan.</u> Please note this sample provides a structure and details; however you must use your original learning objectives, and develop activities that match those.

Please note you are presenting this plan as though you are presenting directly to your students!

Part 1: Title and learning objectives

Addressing your students directly, provide a title and description of your learning unit. Following the description, post a statement of duration for your learning unit, and how much time students should expect to spend on this unit (estimated). For instance, the unit might be one-week in length, and students might expect to spend 9-10 hours on the readings and activities. Below your description, list at least three learning objectives in a numbered list. This list will be preceded by the phrase, "By the completion of this learning unit, you will be able to..."

Reminder: no learning objectives should begin with the verb "understand" or "learn."


Part 2: Content items

Again, addressing your students directly, list at least two **content resources** for your assignment, and **describe to your students how each content item supports the learning objectives:**


- 1. **Content item #1**: Provide a detailed description of anything (written lecture, textbook chapter, etc.) you will use to provide resources for your students to scaffold their learning.
- 2. **Content item #2**: List an existing web resource (learning resource found in MERLOT, a YouTube video, a website, an online article, etc.) that provides an additional method (other than reading) of engaging with the content (find instructions below).

Follow these steps to create a hyperlink for your text:

- 1. Type in your text on the page, and then select the text.
- 2. Click on the "insert/edit link" icon in the editor it looks like a chain link.



- 3. In the pop up window, enter the URL, and "Update Link"
- Close the box and Canvas will create a link for you!



Part 3: Activities and Assessments

Addressing your students directly, describe in detail your learning activities and assessments. Your activities should support achievement of the learning objectives. Directly align activities and assessments with your objectives, and match the verb choice.

- 1. Activity #1: Describe an activity that requires reflective analysis of the learning content, and which supports at least one of your learning objectives. Describe which objective is supported, and how the students will demonstrate their mastery of this action.
- 2. Activity #2: Describe an activity that facilitates interaction between students and provides opportunity for you to send feedback to students. This activity may take the form of a discussion forum to foster group dialogue and feedback, a collaboration to facilitate a team project or presentation, a peer-review activity, or any other creative activity you have in mind. It applicable, apply what you learned this week about designing effective discussion questions. Include the prompt for students to respond to, important student instructions, and specific criteria for replies. If this is a team project, peer-review activity, etc...include the instructions for your students, including how they will collaborate. Describe which objective is supported by your activity.
- 3. **Formative Assessment**: Describe a formative assessment that matches the objective and verb you are assessing, such as an auto-graded online quiz with automated feedback to students, a discussion as mentioned above, or another specific form of formative assessment. How will this assessment support at least one learning objective? How will this assessment support students in building skills and knowledge to achieve a summative assessment later in the course? If your formative assessment is a discussion, how will you assess their responses? Briefly describe a rubric for a discussion.
