## 2019 SEAOSC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The Structural Engineers Association of Southern California (SEAOSC) is pleased to announce the 2019 Structural Engineers Association of Southern California (SEAOSC) Foundation Scholarships. The SEAOSC Foundation is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to advance the study of the scientific principles of structural engineering through the sponsoring of scientific research and the awarding of tuition scholarships for students enrolled in structural engineering programs at accredited institutions of higher learning. The SEAOSC Foundation will provide their 2019 scholarships at the 2019 SEAOSC Student Scholarships Awards Night held on February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

In previous years, scholarship recipients have received awards between \$800 and \$2,000. This year's awards may vary depending on the generous contributions from the structural engineering community and construction related industry.

Criteria for nomination is based on excellence in both academics and leadership with the desire to pursue a career in structural engineering. All students who wish to be considered for a scholarship must submit the following information by **5 PM on Friday, December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018:**

- ◆ A statement of purpose for your future career in structural engineering (two pages maximum);
- ◆ A resume of relevant job experience, if applicable, achievements, and activities;
- ◆ An unofficial transcript;
- ◆ A letter of recommendation from an engineering professor.

Please email all submittals in PDF format, along with your contact information, to [mdaciolas@structuralfocus.com](mailto:mdaciolas@structuralfocus.com). Winners will be notified by **January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.

The scholarship awards will be presented on Wednesday, February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at the annual SEAOSC Student Scholarships Award Night. All civil/structural engineering students and faculty are invited to

attend the event free of charge as guests of SEAOSC. Scholarship winners will be required to attend the event in order to receive their awards.

All students are encouraged to attend SEAOSC's Annual Student Career Fair, featuring prominent structural engineering and industry firms from the Southern California area. The career fair will also be held on February 6<sup>th</sup> before the scholarship awards dinner.

SEAOSC membership is free to current students interested in structural engineering and enrolled full-time in an accredited engineering college or university.
