



2022-23 Academic Year Fellowships & Scholarships

The ACI Foundation offers fellowships and scholarships to support undergraduate and graduate students whose studies relate to concrete (construction, design, education, or materials).

AWARDS

Nineteen (19) \$10,000 fellowships and one (1) \$15,000 fellowship with paid travel expenses to two ACI conventions and ten (10) \$5,000 scholarships are offered to undergraduate and graduate students.

Nearly 25% of awards are accompanied by a summer internship at leading professional organizations, construction companies, and structural design firms in the concrete industry.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Undergraduate and graduate students majoring in architecture; architectural, civil, or structural engineering; concrete industry or construction management; and materials science are eligible.

Region-specific awards are available for students in the Carolinas, Georgia, Iowa, Louisiana, Rocky Mountain Region (USA); Ontario (Canada); and Gulf Cooperation Council nations of the Middle East and specific North African countries.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Completed online application form, including:

- Résumé
- Essay (500-word maximum)
- Official academic transcripts
- Two endorsements are required, and one must be from a current ACI member. (*Consider asking faculty or a concrete practitioner to endorse you.*)
- If applicant's native language is not English, a brief writing sample or copy of the English Proficiency TOEFL Score is requested.
