The San Luis Obispo Branch of ASCE is seeking candidates for a \$1,000 scholarship to be awarded to a qualified and active member of the Society of Civil Engineers (SCE) at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo.

Scholarship Application Submittal Process:

To apply for the scholarship, candidates must submit **one (1) electronic copy** of the below items to jorge.vanegas-moran@ghd.com by **3:00 p.m. on Friday, April 23, 2021**.

Electronic submittals will receive a confirmation of receipt via email. The successful candidate will be notified by Friday, May 14, 2021. The scholarship will be presented at the virtual ASCE SLO Branch Meeting on Thursday, May 20, 2021.

Candidates must meet the following criteria to be eligible for the scholarship:

1. Be an active member, in good standing, of SCE at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo (SLO) and an ASCE student member at the time of application and award.
2. Have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5
3. Have completed at least one year as a full-time student at Cal Poly, SLO.
4. Be a full-time undergraduate student graduating in December 2021 or later.
5. Be declared as a Cal Poly, SLO Civil or Environmental Engineering major.
6. Not be a past recipient of an ASCE SLO Branch Scholarship.

Candidates must submit the following information for consideration:

1. Resume (current contact information, honors, activities, community service, organizations, SCE activities, and work experience, maximum two pages)
2. Letter Essay (stating career goals and aspirations in the field of engineering or civil/environmental engineering, and why/how the scholarship will benefit you, 1000-word maximum)
3. One letter of recommendation from a current faculty member of Cal Poly, SLO College of Engineering (please request faculty member to submit directly by email to jorge.vanegas-moran@ghd.com)
4. An unofficial transcript from Cal Poly, SLO.
