3. Be prepared to discuss your project during the 5-minute Q&A
4. The 10 campus winners move on to the virtual 2021 CSUwide Student Research Competition
 - Hosted by Cal Poly Pomona on April 30 & May 1, 2021
 - Same virtual format



Helpful Hints

1. Review the website information at the Office of Student Research.
2. Work with your advisor to polish your original paper submission.
3. Clarity counts! With limited space and time, make every word count.
4. Use appropriate formatting for paper and presentation.
5. Include citations with consistent formatting.
6. Remember that you are the expert and be prepared to answer questions in a thoughtful and informative way.
