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Concentration Courses	An Individualized Course of Study should consist of 28 quarter units, with at least 16 quarter units at the 300-400 level (or 3000-4000 level under semesters). Courses are selected by the student in consultation with an advising faculty member. The student must also provide a written justification for the courses and the way they constitute a cohesive, integrated course of study. The list of courses is a contract between the student and the Department.
