





An Individualized Course of Study consists of **16 semester units of coursework** to be selected by the student in consultation with and approved by a faculty advisor.

#### At least 8 of the 16 units must be at the 3000-4000 (upper-division) level

(except for students entering with an Anthropology or Geography Associate Degree for Transfer).

The student must also provide a written justification for the courses and the way they constitute a cohesive, integrated course of study. The list of courses is a contract between the student and the Department.
