### Concentration Courses

ICS concentration consists of **21 semester units**.  
**A minimum of 12 semester must be upper-division (300-400 or 3000-4000 level).**  
**A minimum of 6 semester must be Graphic Communication.**

The student selects concentration courses in consultation with the concentration coordinator and department head. Student must provide written justification for the courses and the way they constitute a cohesive, integrated program of study. The list of courses serves as a contract between the student and the Graphic Communication Department.
