An Individualized Course of study consists of 21 semester units of coursework to be selected by the student and approved by the student's faculty advisor. 12 of the 21 units must be at the 3000-4000 (upper-division) level and 12 units must be a POLS prefix. The 12 units of upper-division coursework are not required to be the same 12 units as the POLS-prefix courses. The list of courses is a contract between the student and the Department.
