SUGGESTED COURSES FOR ANTHROPOLOGY-GEOGRAPHY (ANG)

- I. Know your Catalog. Check your DPR or PolyProfile to confirm your catalog year. This will determine your course and degree requirements.
- II. Recommend 12-16 units for fall quarter 2023
- III. Major Courses:
 - Any upper-division ANT or GEOG (at least 8 units recommended). Some seats have been reserves for new transfers in ANT 360 and GEOG 308, 350 and, 380.
- IV. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - Some combination of an upper-division C GE course or upper division B GE course, if needed to reach 12-16 units total. Note: upper division B may be built into your concentration. Check your curriculum sheet.
- V. Additional Notes:
 - GEOG 318: Applications in GIS is now GEOG 218: Applications in GIS. Taking GEOG 218 will fulfill GEOG 318 in your curriculum.
 - On the 2020-2021 catalog, GEOG 333: Human Impact on the Earth will no longer be offered. GEOG 350: The Global Environment (UD B GE) should be taken in its place and a substitution form completed with the department. Note that GEOG 350 will also fulfill your Upper Division B GE, but it cannot also be used in your concentration, you will need to complete a different option.
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>
 - To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder screen and search by GWR.
 - Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement – classes also can be found in Schedule Builder.
