

SUGGESTED COURSES FOR ART & DESIGN (ART)

- I. Know your Catalog. Check your DPR or PolyProfile to confirm your catalog year. This will determine your course and degree requirements.
- II. Recommend 12-16 units for fall quarter 2023

III. Major Courses:

- Credit in ART 102 and 182 may need to be assessed by the Department Chair. If your transfer evaluation does not show completion of ART 102 or 182, you can talk with the Department Chair during Transfer SLO Days.
- All Concentrations: take ART 101 if not already completed.
- <u>Graphic Design Concentration</u>: Art 182 or advanced courses based on department chair review and approval during Transfer SLO Days. Additional possibilities *might* include an Art history course (upper division **only if** lower division already completed) ART 203, 224, or 237.
- <u>Photo Concentration</u>: Art 182 or advanced courses based on department chair review and approval during Transfer SLO Days. Additional possibilities *might* include an Art history course (upper division **only if** lower division already completed) ART 203, 222, or 224.
- <u>Studio Concentration</u>: Art 148 or 182, or advanced courses based on department chair review and approval during Transfer SLO Days. Additional possibilities *might* include an Art history course (upper division **only if** lower division already completed) ART 203, 224, or 302.

IV. General Education (GE) Courses:

- Diversity Elective (upper division D GE), see curriculum sheet for course options and compare with availability on Schedule Builder
- Upper-Division B GE course, if needed to reach 12-16 units total.

V. Additional Notes:

- The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR
- To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder screen and search by GWR.
- Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement
