## **SUGGESTED COURSES FOR CHILD DEVELOPMENT (CD)**

- I. New CD transfer students will begin on the 2022-2026 quarter catalog, and we recommend changing to the 2026-2028 semester catalog after the first year. This will be discussed at TR SLO Days and throughout the year.
- II. Recommend 14 units for Fall Quarter 2025
- III. Major Courses: 10 units of major-related courses are recommended.
  - CD 102 – *must be completed at Cal Poly in Fall.*
  - *If not yet completed:* CD / PSY 254, and /or CD / PSY 256.
  - If CD / PSY 256 has been completed, other options are CD 304, 350, 356 or 460.
  - Research Courses
    - If you have credit for a lower division research course, take CD 329 this first year
    - If you don't have credit for a lower division research course, take CD 207 this winter or spring (keep an eye out for communication on CD 270 this winter or spring).
      - Then plan to take CD 3329 second year in the fall along with CD 4461.
- IV. Support Courses:
  - *If not yet completed,* any lower division courses listed in support.
- V. General Education (GE) Courses:
  - Any UD-C Course
  - UD-D Course: ES 380
- VI. Additional Notes:
  - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>
  - To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder screen and search by GWR.
  - Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement – classes also can be found in Schedule Builder.
