

SUGGESTED COURSES FOR SOCIOLOGY (SOC)

- I. Know your Catalog. Check your DPR or PolyProfile to confirm your catalog year. This will determine your course and degree requirements.
- II. Recommend 12-16 units for fall quarter 2023
- III. Major Courses:
 - SOC 110 and/or SOC 111, *if not completed*.
 - SOC 216, *if not completed*.
 - Any Upper-Division SOC electives or core courses, if prerequisites have been completed. Some seats have been reserved for new transfers in SOC 315, 355 and 406.
 - Any Upper Division ANT or GEOG elective.
- IV. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - Some combination of an Upper Division B, Upper Division C, and/or Upper Division D GE course, if needed to reach 12-16 units total.
- V. Additional Notes:
 - SOC 316: US Ethnic Minorities on the 2020-2021 catalog is now SOC 216: US Race and Ethnic Relations. If not completed, taking SOC 216 will fulfill SOC 316 in your curriculum.
 - SOC 421: Social Theory on both the 2020-2021 & 2021-2022 catalogs is now SOC 222: Classical Social Theory. Taking SOC 222 will fulfill SOC 421 in your curriculum.
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>
 - To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder screen and search by GWR.
 - Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement – classes also can be found in Schedule Builder.
