

# Suggested Courses For English (engl)

- I. Know your Catalog. Check your DPR or PolyProfile to confirm your catalog year. This will determine your course and degree requirements.
- II. Recommend 12-16 units for fall guarter 2023

#### III. Major Courses:

- ENGL 204 Sequence II. All new transfers must take ENGL 204 fall quarter.
  Permission number from department required
- ENGL 304 Sequence V. All new transfers must take ENGL 304 fall quarter. Permission number from department required
- ENGL 220 or 290, if not yet completed. Some seats are reserved for new transfers. Note: If you have taken an unused fiction writing, poetry writing, or screenwriting course, it will be used as a substitute for ENGL 220.

### IV. Support Courses:

• CHIN, FR, GER, ITAL, JPNS, or SPAN 201, *if not yet completed, and if eligible,* (students with less preparation in the chosen language should enroll in 101, 102, or 103 and work their way up to 201). All levels of SPAN are offered Fall quarter; other languages are only offered at the 101 and 201 levels Fall quarter.

## V. General Education (GE) Courses:

• Some combination of an Upper Division B GE, Non-ENGL Upper Division C GE, or Upper Division D GE, if needed to reach 12-16 units total.

#### VI. Additional Notes:

- English Transfer students are NOT required to take ENGL 202 or ENGL 203. These will be substituted with transfer courses in literature or writing.
- The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-approved course OR earn a passing score on a GWR portfolio. Since English majors need to take 300-level ENGL courses, most majors complete the requirement through their scheduled classes. For GWR information, please visit the Writing and Learning Center web page. To find out which classes you can use to satisfy the GWR, use the GWR filter in <u>Schedule Builder</u>.
- Students must satisfy the <u>United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP)</u> requirement before graduation. English majors fulfill this requirement through an ENGL course in the major (ENGL 345, 346, 347, 349, or 381).
