



SUGGESTED COURSES FOR ENGLISH (ENGL)

- I. New transfer students will be placed on the 2026-2028 Catalog.
- II. Recommend 15-16 semester units for fall semester 2026.
- III. Major Courses to choose from:
 - A 4 unit 2000 level designated ENGL elective, *if up to three courses not fulfilled with transfer credit*, check DPR. See catalog for list of course options.
 - Any 3000 level Intermediate Study ENGL elective. See catalog for list of course options. Seats reserved in many options. Check Schedule Builder.
 - ENGL 3611 as fall available ENGL Upper Division 3 GE/GWR.
- IV. Support Courses:
 - CHIN, FR, GER, ITAL, JPNS, or SPAN 1101, *if not yet completed, and if eligible*.
 - All levels of SPAN are offered Fall semester; other languages are only offered at the 1101 and 2201 levels in Fall semester.
- V. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - An Upper Division 2/5 GE or Upper Division 4 GE, if needed to reach 15-16 total units. Note: UD 3 GE will be fulfilled with major coursework.
- VI. Additional Notes:
 - **English Transfer students are NOT required to take ENGL 1101. This course will be substituted with a transfer course in literature.**
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-approved course OR earn a passing score on a GWR portfolio. Since English majors need to take 3000-level ENGL courses, most majors complete the requirement through their scheduled classes.  - Students must satisfy the [United States Cultural Pluralism \(USCP\)](#) requirement. Classes can be found in Schedule Builder and can be combined with ENGL courses or Upper Division GEs.
