STAT 217, if not yet completed.

V. General Education (GE) Courses:

An upper-division C GE course, if needed to reach 12-16 units total.

VI. Additional Notes:

- The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-approved, upper-division course OR by registering for the Writing Proficiency Examination (WPE).
