SUGGESTED COURSES FOR COMPARATIVE ETHNIC STUDIES (ES)

- I. New ES transfer students will begin on the 2022-2026 quarter catalog, with the option to change to the 2026-2028 semester catalog after the first year. This will be discussed at TR SLO Days and throughout the year.
- II. Recommend 12-16 units for fall quarter 2025
- III. Major Courses:
 - Any lower ES requirements in the major not yet completed.
 - Any upper division ES requirements in the major. Please check prerequisites. Some seats are reserved in ES 345 (GE UD D), 350 (GE UD B), and 380 (GE UD D).
 - Any 300-400 level ES electives(see catalog for details). Please check prerequisites.
- IV. Support Courses:
 - STAT 217, **ONLY** if not yet completed and planning to stay on the quarter catalog.
- V. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - An Upper-Division C GE course (ES 300-303; ES 324; or ES 340), if needed to reach 12-16 units total.
- VI. Additional Notes:
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-approved, upper-division course OR by registering for the Writing Proficiency Examination (WPE).  - To find out which classes you can use to satisfy the GWR, using the GWR filter in [Schedule Builder](#).
 - Students must satisfy the [United States Cultural Pluralism \(USCP\)](#) requirement before graduation. Ethnic Studies majors will fulfill this requirement through the required ES 345.
