

SUGGESTED COURSES FOR INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES (IS)

- I. Know your Catalog. Check your DPR or PolyProfile to confirm your catalog year. This will determine your course and degree requirements.
- II. Recommend 12-16 units for fall quarter 2023
- III. Major Courses:
Based on availability
 - ISLA 201 (permission number to enroll will be provided by the department during Transfer SLO Days, email Dr Kirby if you are unable to attend)
 - ISLA 303 or 320 if on 22-26 catalog or courses listed in planned emphasis area or concentration.
 - Any courses in planned emphasis area or concentration if prerequisites have been met.
- IV. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - Some combination of upper division B and/or D GE courses, if needed to reach 12-16 units. Some emphasis areas may have upper division B or D GEs options to choose from which will double count for both requirements.
- V. Additional Notes:
 - If not completed, one of: ES 112, HIST 206 or 216, ISLA 123, JOUR 219 or 228, RELS 201, WGQS 201 or 210 will be substituted with any interdisciplinary related transfer course.
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>. To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder screen and search by GWR.
 - Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement – classes also can be found in Schedule Builder. Interdisciplinary majors will fulfill the USCP requirement with PHIL 335 in their major.
