

SUGGESTED COURSES FOR INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES (IS)

- I. New transfer students will be placed on the 2026-2028 Catalog.
- II. Recommend 15-16 semester units for fall semester 2026.
- III. Major Courses:
 - ISLA 1101: First Year Seminar, 1 unit.
 - ISLA 2201. Permission number to enroll will be provided by the department during Transfer SLO Days. Email Dr Kirby with your preferred section if you are unable to attend.
 - ISLA 2255. Permission number to enroll will be provided by the department during Transfer SLO Days. Email Dr Kirby with your preferred section if you are unable to attend.
 - Any open Upper Division ISLA elective. Some seats reserved in ISLA 3303 and 3320.
 - Any open courses in your chosen concentration, if prerequisites have been met.
- IV. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - Some combination of Upper Division 2/5, 3 or 4 GE courses, if needed to reach 15-16 units. Some concentrations may have Upper Division GEs courses to choose from which will double count for concentration and GE.
- V. Additional Notes:
 - **If not completed, the Introductory-level Interdisciplinary Course, one of: ES 1112, HIST 2206 or 2216, ISLA 1123 or 2240, JOUR 2219 or 2228, RELS 2201, WGQS 2201 or 2301 will be substituted with any interdisciplinary related transfer course.**
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder screen and search by GWR.
