

SUGGESTED COURSES FOR PSYCHOLOGY (PSY)

- I. Know your Catalog. Check your DPR or PolyProfile to confirm your catalog year. This will determine your course and degree requirements.
- II. Recommend 14-16 units for Fall Quarter 2023

III. Major Courses:

- PSY 102 All new transfers must take this course Fall 2023
- Any lower-division PSY prefix course(s) not yet completed, as available PSY 252, 256 (please note that PSY 254 is not a required course for PSY majors)
- PSY 300-level electives or core courses* (8 units recommended; please check prerequisites)*

• If not yet completed, any courses listed in support.

V. General Education (GE) Courses:

• Some combination of upper division C, and/or D GE courses, if needed to reach 14-16 units total.
