



SUGGESTED COURSES FOR PSYCHOLOGY (PSY)

- I. New PSY transfer students will begin on the 2022-2026 quarter catalog, and we recommend changing to the 2026-2028 semester catalog after the first year. This will be discussed at TR SLO Days and throughout the year.
- II. Recommend 14 units for Fall Quarter 2025
- III. Major Courses:
 - PSY 102 - All new transfers must take this course Fall 2025.
 - PSY 252 or 256 - *if not already complete.*
 - PSY 300-level electives or core courses (8 units recommended; please check prerequisites). Some seats have been reserved for new transfer students in: PSY 305, 311, 318, 340, 370, 372, 375 and 405.
 - Research Courses:
 - If you have credit for a lower division research course, take PSY 333 this first year. If taken your first year, you will need a permission number.
 - If you don't have credit for a lower division research course, take PSY 329 this year.
- IV. Support Courses:
 - *If not yet completed*, any courses listed in support.
- V. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - Any UD-C Course
 - UD-D Course: ES 380
- VI. Additional Notes:
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>
 - To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder screen and search by GWR.
 - Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement – classes also can be found in Schedule Builder. Psychology majors will fulfill the USCP requirement with PSY 372 in their major.
