

SUGGESTED COURSES FOR PSYCHOLOGY (PSY)

- I. New transfer students will be placed on the 2026-2028 Catalog.
- II. Recommend 15-16 semester units for fall semester 2026.
- III. Major Courses:
 - PSY 1102 - All new transfers must take this course Fall 2026.
 - PSY 2205, 2252 or 2256 - *if not already complete.*
 - PSY 2240 - *if not already complete.*
 - Research Courses:
 - If you have credit for a lower division research course, take PSY 3333 this first year.
 - If you don't have credit for a lower division research course, take CD/PSY 2229 fall.
 - PSY 3000-4000 level electives or core courses (please check prerequisites).
 - Prioritize courses from the Health, Social/Personality, and Cognitive electives. See catalog for course lists.
 - Some seats have been reserved for new transfer students in: PSY 3302, 3320, 3323, 3357, 3370, 3372, 4460.
- IV. Support Courses:
 - *If not yet completed*, any courses listed in support.
- V. General Education (GE) Courses:
 - Any Upper Division 3 GE course. Note: Upper Division 2/5 and Upper Division 4 GEs will be fulfilled with required major courses.
- VI. Additional Notes:
 - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>
 - To find out which classes can satisfy the GWR, select "Expand Filters" in the upper right-hand corner of the Schedule Builder and search by GWR.
 - Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement – classes also can be found in Schedule Builder. Psychology majors will fulfill the USCP requirement with PSY 372 in their major.
