

## SUGGESTED COURSES FOR SPANISH (SPAN)

- I. New transfer students will be placed on the 2026-2028 Catalog.
- II. Recommend 15-16 semester units for fall semester 2026.
- III. Major Courses:
  - If needed, Intermediate Spanish – one of: SPAN 2201, 2202/2206, taking into account your level and prior credit.
  - If SPAN 2202/2206 has been completed, take SPAN 2207 and/or SPAN 2233 [Note: SPAN 2207 is only offered in Fall]
  - If SPAN 2202/2206 and 2233 have been completed, take SPAN 2207 and/or any available 3000-4000 SPAN course, check prerequisites.
  - Any approved culture electives, see catalog for [list of options](#) and prerequisites. Some seats have been reserved for new transfer students in WLC 3310 and 3312.
- IV. General Education (GE) Courses:
  - Some combination of Upper Division 2/5 and/or 4 GE courses, if needed to reach 15-16 units total. Note: Upper Division 3 may be fulfilled with SPAN 3000 level elective, see catalog course descriptions for options. UD 2/5 and 4 GE courses may be found in required Approved Language/Culture Elective options.
- V. Additional Notes:
  - If needed, placement tests should be taken. Please visit <https://wlc.calpoly.edu/students/placement-exam> for more information and available times. SPAN majors may need to finalize their schedules for major courses during WOW week, if the placement test is needed.
  - The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit <https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR>
  - Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement – classes also can be found in Schedule Builder.
