Article I - Name

The name of this organization shall be "Semper Fi Society".

Article II - Mission

Article III - Membership

1. Maintain a 2.0 GPA for the academic year

2. Members must remain in good standing by attending physical training and participating in

knowledge sessions

3. No person shall be excluded on the basis of race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or disability.

Article IV - Officers

1. The officers of this club shall consist of:

2. Officers shall be elected by competency of role by club president once per year.

3. Duties:
