# Liberal Studies (LS)

## Course Load

As you adjust to the quarter system and/or a new environment, we recommend enrolling in 12-16 units, with no more than 1 lab.

All course descriptions can be found in the Cal Poly Catalog.

# **Course Suggestions**

Pay special attention to the footnotes on your curriculum sheet. If a major or concentration course is also a GE, it can be used to fulfill both the major or concentration and GE requirements.

### **MAJOR**

- LS 301: Liberal Studies Career Preparation (1 unit, offered Fall and Spring quarters)
- LS 230 or LS 250: Classroom Field Experience (2 units). You may take these in any order but never take them during the same quarter.
- Take one, two or three of these courses with only one being an upper division course (a 300 or 400 level course): LS 211, LS 214, LS 255, ENGL 391 or GEOG 308\*, KINE 310 or HLTH 443 (4 12 units)
- If needed, take: ASTR 101, HIST 201, HIST 208, HIST 210, PSC 101, PSY 201/202, STAT 217, or EDUC 207 (0 4 units)
- Consider retaking MATH 227: Mathematics for Teaching Elementary I (0-4 units).
  - Note: We generally recommend that you take the entire Math teaching series at Cal Poly, unless you took a rigorous, student centered, inquiry-based course at your previous college. Please speak with an advisor if you're unsure about your MATH transfer credit/placement. We find that students that re-take MATH 227 do better in the following math series courses.

\*GE Area D Upper Division will be satisfied through completion of GEOG 308. Global Geography

### **CONCENTRATION**

Concentration course selection will depend on your chosen concentration.

- If you are planning to declare the Science concentration, complete any remaining lower-division courses in CHEM, PHYS, or BIO.
- If you are planning to declare the Mathematics or Spanish concentration, or if you are unsure which concentration you should follow, please consult with an advisor.

### **GENERAL EDUCATION**

If needed, complete any remaining lower-division GE courses. Otherwise, select an upper-division GE course from area B or C. Some GE courses may also be used to satisfy major or concentration requirements.

# Other Graduation Requirements

### **GWR**

The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upper-division course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio- UNIV 401. For more info on the GWR, visit <a href="https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR">https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR</a>

### **USCP**

Students must satisfy the United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) requirement.

• HIST 201, HIST 208 will satisfy the USCP which are major courses.
